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## NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE

Interstate Power and Light, Co. plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit No. 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities."

The storm water discharge will be from land disturbance within road right-of-way due to utility construction activities associated with replacement of overhead electric distribution systems with new overhead electric and underground electric distribution systems. The project route will be located in Sections 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32 of Township 84 North, Range 26 West and in Sections 5

and 6 of Township 83 North, Range 26 West. These sections are located in Boone County, Iowa. Stormwater will be discharged by surface drainage to Polecat Creek, Honey Creek and two unnamed tributaries to the Des Moines River.

Comments may be submitted to the Storm Water Discharge Coordinator, Iowa Department of Natural Resources, Environmental Protection Division, 900 E. Grand Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50319-0034. The public may review the Notice of Intent from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the above address after it has been received by the department.
